Safe use of gas cylinders

Do's



- In the event of a fire telephone 999 or 112 to call the Fire Brigade. Tell them gas cylinders are on the premises.
- Keep all gas cylinders in a safe, well-ventilated place, preferably in the open air and away from any sources of ignition and heat.
- If you think you have a leak at a gas cylinder or associated pipework call Guernsey Gas on 724811 so they can come and make safe free of charge.
- If the gas leak is indoors, open all the windows and doors to ventilate the rooms.
- If there is a leak in the pipework, close the emergency valve or valve on the cylinder, but only if safe to do so.
- Gas cylinders should always be stored in the upright position.
- Contact Guernsey Gas for free advice if you are proposing to make alterations to your property which could affect your gas supply.
- Make sure on cylinder delivery days that the parking area is clear for our delivery vehicle to unload.
- If your gas cylinder is no longer required Kosangas will collect it from your premises free of charge.
- Read the instructions/labels provided with your appliance and keep them in a safe place for future reference.

Don'ts



- In the event of a gas leak don't smoke, use naked lights, turn electric switches on or off, use your telephone or ring the doorbell.
- Don't try to put out a fire involving gas cylinders, call the Fire Brigade on 999 or 112.
It's safer to evacuate everyone from the area.
- Don't put full or empty propane cylinders indoors.
- Don't carry out any modifications which may affect the safety of the gas installation such as altering walls, erecting sheds, fences or installing electrical equipment near the gas cylinders.
- Don't let anyone work on the gas installation unless they are suitably qualified and competent to carry out the work.
- Don't keep rubbish or anything combustible close to cylinders and keep weeds and grass in the immediate vicinity cut down.
